

Joint Meeting Town of Washington Village of Cecil 10-21-15

The meeting was called to order at 6:30PM by J Nolan of the Village of Cecil.

Those attending the meeting were P Westcott, J Slatky, J Nolan, T Sumnicht, C Wallrich, A Kallies (6:40) from the Village of Cecil, K Skarlupka, J Mitchell, D Sumnicht, S Wegner from the Town of Washington.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The meeting was posted both by the Village of Cecil and the Town of Washington.

The roof leak in the Fire Hall was looked at on Tuesday by Northern, the same people who repaired the roof. A plan for truck/equipment replacement should be prepared by the Fire Department for the future.

Road Concerns: Freeborn Street-There are still 2 resident holdups to the road construction. The Village was requested to work with Zahn's over the driveway into the field. Access on Pine Road-There are continued complaints from residents on farm machinery tearing up the road. A request will be made to Green Valley Farms to apply for a driveway into the field from Hwy 117, suggested place would be the southwest corner of the field with close access to Hwy 117.

Implements of Husbandry: The Town of Washington chose Option F as well as Shawano County. This allows 92,000 pounds in combination on the roadway. The Town received only 2 applications (Wussow Farms and Green Valley Farms). The Town asked that no bridges be used by the applicants. The DOT needs to be notified. The Village will need to follow the Town of Washington on Option F and email DOT with the decision.

The walls in the hall damaged by the leaking will need to be repainted. Maintenance will be notified of this.

Emergency Management-Link to the Shawano Co Website to be in compliance for the time being.

New chairs for the Hall area-Currently we will look into prices and get an okay from each Board before proceeding.
