He would like to get in a load of salt/sand this season and keep it at the shop. Broom Box for the loader is something the maintenance department would like to budget for future. He would like to get a load of shoulder gravel before winter. Grunewald will be contacted for the dump station, Marohl will be contacted for tree removal. There are campers asking for 50amp services, Dewey is asking for someone to look at the electrical system. Sewers-he has rebuilt 14 manholes this last month.

Hwy 22 Road Construction-there will be a meeting in the future at the village hall

Primal Eats--Scott Follett-Restaurant at the BP -130' deck out over the hill at the gas station, ribs, chicken, bbq & broasted, fish on Friday night, he already has approval from the DNR for 10,000 ft to be filled in for pillars and a boardwalk, he is currently applying for a parking lot across from the turn out on Hwy 22. He is asking for the village to put in additional docks at the turn out. He took down Leona Wegner's home and found that the original log structure was the founder of Cecil's home, Cecil Leavitt. He is hoping to create for Cecil a destination. He is working with the DNR right now to fill in the swamp area below the Lakeview Convenience-BP Station to be able to build in that area. He is asking Cecil for dock space, road assistance, also the home for about \$15,000. He would like answers on these questions in the next month.

Motion made by J Maule that if the DOT approves a driveway on 22 off of the Lakeview Convenience property, the Village of Cecil will approve said driveway, seconded by C Wallrich, motion carried.
