Motion made by A Kallies to approve and deviate from the agenda, seconded by M Hendricks, motion carried.

Motion made to approve the meeting minutes and treasurer's report from April 21st, 2026 by M Hendricks, seconded by A Kallies. Motion carried.

Public Comment-K VandenPlas-Walleyes for Tomorrow-Thanking the board for the Walleye Hatchery success this season, snow plowing included. Planning on next year with the board approval, the electric line was run and used this season as well as a cable line set up for the hatchery.

Maintenance Report-R Weier-Dock is in, boat slips they are working on, gate has been installed, speed bumps will be installed, 2 water leaks in the park, the bathroom needed to be pumped, shower leak repaired, some road patching, there is lawn needing repair. Eric has put in his resignation with a 2 week notice. The courtesy dock in the park will be installed this week. The new pump for the lift station is on order, 90 day wait for delivery. We will need someone to rebuild the old pump. At the end of Baehr Street there was a load of weeds again. A speed limit sign was requested for Baehr Street.

Clerk's Report-was included in the packet

LRIP-Road Award-Lemke Street-\$12,919.00 awarded and the cost estimate was \$36,000.00, R Weier will take care of the bidding process for the street project. Motion made by R Weier to offer bids for Lemke Street, seconded by C Wallrich, motion carried.

Road Closure impact on trucking firms in the village.- June 1st- 26th is the estimate for road closure. The closure planned from Hwy 117 to Cty R.

Park Broker Price Opinion and properties owned by the village-27 acres at the Yard Waste Site, The League of WI Municipalities will be contacted for more information. Broker Price Opinion also requested.

Wm Behnke-suggestions on campground, sidewalks and fuel surcharges. He would like to drive through the village with his empty semi trucks, if he is not allowed, then he feels that beer trucks, and food delivery trucks should also not be allowed. Wm Behnke wants the village board to watch the bridge construction, but was informed that only the decking will be replaced on Hwy 22. Wm Behnke has agreed not to run through the village for the 26 days that the Hwy will be closed.

Motion made by A Kallies to purchase Weight Limit 10 ton signs, seconded by C Wallrich, motion carried.
